In Memory of Nancy Hoover


August 17, 1927 – April 4, 2022



Zimmerman House is the home of one of the Beautiful "Madame Caroline Rose" that was planted. In the years leading up to 1905's Lewis and Clark Centennial Exposition, tens of thousands of "Madame Caroline Tea Rose." were planted in home gardens and along Portland's streets curbs, to create a soft fragrant with pink blossoms.
